

Dal-Metro TEDA Professional Scholarship Guidelines 2021-2022

Applicant Overview

Eligibility

1. All applicants must be seeking an undergraduate degree in Special Education or a Master's Degree as an Educational Diagnostician, an added certification as an Educational Diagnostician, or Region 10 certification as an Educational Diagnostician.
2. They must reside or work in Region 10.
3. The money will be awarded for continuing the educational program during the Summer or the Fall semester of the following school year. (No money is awarded for coursework previously completed.)

Application Process

The following items will be required for the application process:

1. Applicant Application Letter

This letter is an important part of the application process; so please give careful thought and consideration to your response. Applicant letter must include:

- Name
- Address
- City/State/Zip
- Phone #
- E-mail address
- Educational plans
- Career plans and aspirations
- Planned use for scholarship funds

2. Reference letters

Please provide two (2) reference letters. The letter must be dated and include name, email address and phone number where the reference can be contacted. References should be professionals that have worked with you and may come from the following sources **and may not include a family member.**

- Educational Diagnostician
- Teacher/Professor
- School Administrator
- Co-worker

3. Applicant Educational Information:

- Most recent transcript (**Fall 2021**) All applicants are required to turn in a transcript or grades if in a Masters or Bachelors program or the Region 10 program. If starting a Masters program, transcript from undergraduate degree required. Last

transcript received for Masters required if adding Educational Diagnostician Certification.

- Acceptance letter if beginning your undergraduate degree in Special Education, graduate degree or certification as an Educational Diagnostician, or the Region 10 Educational Diagnostician program. **(If beginning your internship through Region 10 a letter from the school district must also be included indicating that you are completing your internship for the next academic school year.)**

Applications Accepted

- Applications will be accepted from March 2, 2022 through April 25, 2022.

Date of Award

- Winner(s) will be notified by letter or e-mail. **Proof of enrollment for the Summer or Fall semester will need to be provided to the chapter treasurer before awarding of any monies.**

Completed Application Package

- Your completed application package must be **postmarked** no later than April 25, 2022. **The application package needs to include all of the required information. Please do not mail until all is complete. Incomplete applications will not be considered. No e-mailed application packets will be accepted.**
